



English:

We will be continuing with our Read Write Inc phonics programme at individual levels.



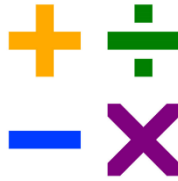
In reading, we will be continuing to develop the skill of decoding words, as well as reading for understanding and making predictions about what might happen in the story.

Within classes, we will be looking at stories focussing on characters and settings and poetry. The children will write in sentences using finger spaces between each word, a capital letter to begin each sentence and a full stop at the end. Our texts will be - Peace at last and The Tiger who came to tea.

Maths:

In maths we will be:

- Recognising and writing numbers to 20 as numerals and words.
- Looking at place value within numbers to 20.
- Addition and subtraction using numbers to 10.
- Measuring length and height using standard measures.
- Identifying a range of 2d and 3d shapes.



Geography

We will be looking at where the UK is and naming the 4 countries in the UK. We will also explore compass directions. We will look at the 4 seasons and explore what the weather is like in the UK.

History

We will be learning about how toys have changed throughout time. We will be investigating what toys were like in the past and explore how teddy bears have changed over time.

Art/DT

In art, we will be exploring paper sculptures and making 3D paper models. In DT we will be designing and making puppets.

Music

We will be exploring musical vocabulary and learning about vocal body sounds.

RE and PSHE

In R.E, we will be continuing to explore the Christian faith looking at how Christians see God and exploring the stories and prayers of Jesus.

In PSHE, we will be exploring the topics 'Health and Wellbeing' and 'Economic wellbeing'.

British Values

We will be looking at individual liberty and mutual respect.

Computing:

We will be using a range of computer software and apps to explore digital programming. We will be programming a moving robot.



PE:

In dance and gymnastics, we will be exploring body shape and movement and sequencing actions to create individual and small group dances to music. In games, we will continue to practice our ball skills developing and playing simple team games.

Tuesday is outdoor PE and Thursday is indoor.
