








Make your own simple animal addition sentences. How many do you have in total?   	Science- What is your favourite animal? Draw a picture of your favourite animal and write a few facts about it.
	Look at the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff. Change one thing in the story (you might want to change the goats for a different animal or change the setting). Next with the help of an adult write your new story and draw illustrations.	Using a part whole model can you show all the different ways you can make 10? 	Science- Make a poster that shows the 5 senses. What are the 5 senses? What body parts do we use? Why are our senses important?
