Research the different gods and goddesses they believed in. Choose how you would like to present your work, e.g. as a leaflet or a PowerPoint.</i>
	<i>Pretend you are a Viking invading England. Write a letter home to your family.</i>	<i>Create a timeline of key events during Viking times. Use your timeline to write 5 mathematical word problems.</i>	<i>Research what the Vikings thought about death. Where do they believe they go when they die?</i>

**Challenge:**

*Make a model of a Viking long house or a Viking long boat. Create an interesting collage of a Viking scene, stormy sea, long boat, or a raid! Design a piece of Viking jewellery.*

*These are just a few examples, be as creative as you wish. We look forward to seeing your work.*

Children are expected to read 3 times a week and evidence this on Boomreader.

They will be given spellings on a Monday; they need to practice these for a test every Friday. All spellings can be found on Spelling Shed (children have individual logins).
