

Year 1 Spring Term 2020



English:

We will be continuing with our Read Write Inc phonics programme at individual levels.

In Reading, we will continue to develop the skill of reading for understanding, to read expressively, to make predictions about what might happen in the story and to look at the features of information texts.

Within classes, we will be looking at stories focussing on characters and settings and information texts. The children will be encouraged to write in sentences using finger spaces between each word, a capital letter to begin each sentence and a full stop at the end. We will look at improving our writing by including more detail using adjectives and expanded noun phrases as well as writing at greater length.

Maths:

In maths we will be:

- Understanding the place value of 2 digit numbers.
- Counting in tens and finding 10 more and less than a number.
- Learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Examining money the value of coins to one pound and finding total amounts and working out change.
- Weighing objects and measuring capacity.
- Telling the time to the hour and half past.
- Adding and subtracting numbers.

Computing:

We will be using stop frame animation to create a short film.

We will be remembering: being small, being a baby, learning to crawl, favourite toys, favourite books and thinking about christenings and weddings. We will be looking at family photos of special occasions, perhaps holiday snapshots or a birthday celebration. Children will need to find a funny photo of their parents when they were young. Children will learn how to write a diary of days gone by and find out about the days before they were born. History

We will be learning about toys from the past and the present and past family experiences. Art/D&T

We will be making a memory box from a small box and will decorate it using a range of materials. We will be drawing family portraits. Music

We will be singing and playing instruments to accompany our performance.

RE and PSHE

In R.E, we will be considering God from a Christian point of view and looking at beliefs. We will also look at the celebration of Easter. In PSHE, the children will be thinking about themselves: what makes them proud, their gifts and talents. They will also be setting goals to achieve within school.

Science:

We will be looking at plants and growing a plant from a seed, looking at parts of a plant and what plants need to grow.

British Values:

We will be looking at differences between right and wrong and the rules within society. We will be encouraging the children to explain their own views and listen to others.

PE:

In gymnastics we will be identifying and using basic gymnastic shapes and actions. In dance we will build simple movement patterns.
